

NEW \$100,000 MARKETS TO BE ERECTED HERE

Plans for Modern Structure At Tenth and Franklin Now Being Completed

Details for construction of an up-to-the-minute market, costing \$100,000, at Tenth and Franklin Streets, were being completed today by Fred H. Morgan.

Morgan, who has had 20 years experience in the market and fixture business, is planning a market structure in the Mission style of architecture, containing 30 concessions, and equipped with the latest devices for serving shoppers.

The interior will be plastered and three rows of skylights with windows on three sides will provide ample light.

Associated with Morgan in the venture are Foster Weeks of Weeks Securities Corporation, Oakland, and Victor Challen of San Jose, owners of the California Market in that city.

One of the modern features of the new market will be the limitation of concession stalls to a height of five feet, allowing the customer to see all over the market. The market will have ample floors.

The architect of the project is W. H. Weeks of San Francisco.

Free Market in Oakland Urged

Establishment of a free public market, where farmers can sell their wares from their parked trucks, was advocated in a letter received today by City Manager E. Carr from H. H. Cross, San Francisco attorney, who has business interests in Oakland.

Cross referred to the free public market at Ninth and S Streets, Sacramento, as an example of a successful farmers' market.

Carr, who has been City Manager of several cities in the past, said that his experience indicates that the farmers' market idea does not benefit the householder because merchants get to the wagons first and pick out all the good stuff for their stores.

Commercial Diving For Abalones Halted

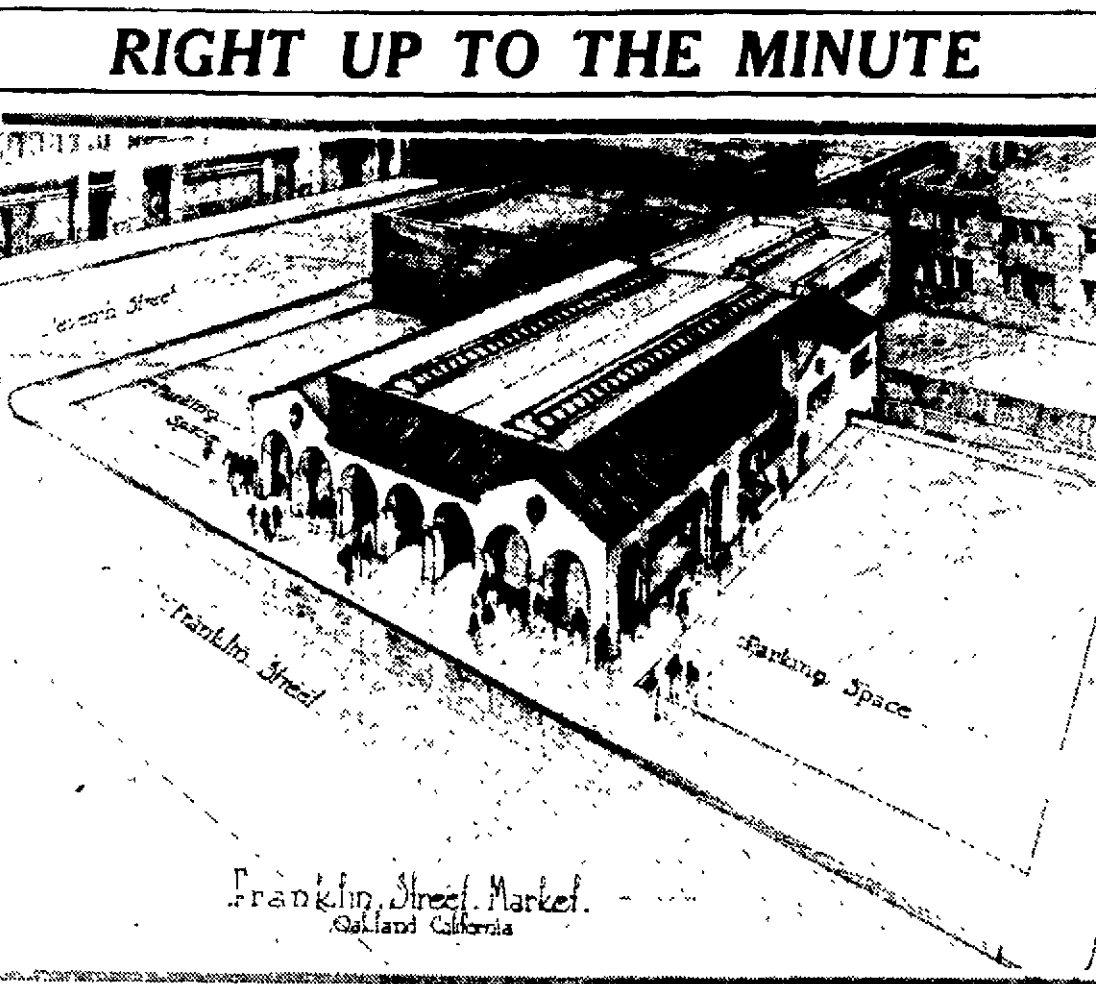

FIREMAN RETIRED

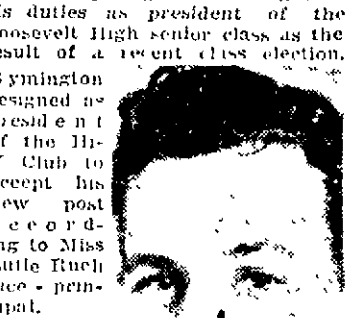
Harry Williams, lieutenant of Engine 24 company, was granted retirement on half-pay today by the firemen's relief and pension board.
