

1000 Parking Meters OK'd

Council Approves of New Installations **By Unanimous Vote**

Orders for the installation of 1000 more of the parking meters now in operation here today had been given by the Oakland City Council.

Installation will begin in 30 days with 700 to be spotted in the central business district, including Grand Avenue in the vicinity of Broadway and Webster Street The remainder are proposed for the Fruitvale business district along East 14th Street from 29th to 38th Avenues

The council action was without a lissenting vote and the resolution directed City Manager John F Hassler to enter into a contract with Michaels Art Bronze Company, Covington, Ky, to furnish the meters

Oakland's 2000 Mi-Co parking meters produce \$20,000 revenue

monthly. Cost of the meters will be \$55 and \$56 each, depending on the type of installation ordered by the city, t was announced

IMMEDIATE DELIVERY

Anticipating future installations under bids submitted last year for a maximum of 7000 meters, the Kentucky firm had set aside the 1000 for Oakland, assuring immediate delivery, the council was informed by Colonel John F. Ohmer and Robert E Foote. MI-Co representatives. In contrast to repeated squabbles last year when selection of a parking meter was before the council, the issue was quickly disposed of as most of the members urged further purchases of the MI-Co meter in the interest of protecting the motoring public from "confusion" City Manager Hassler advised the council that seven types of meters had been received by his office for inspection by officials and quoted installation prices of each


